The Year 11 compulsory fieldwork will take place on **Tuesday 19th September (11Y1 and 11G1) and Wednesday 20th September (11G2 and 11Y2), 9am to 3pm.**

We will leave school at 9.00 (register in form then go to the coach turning circle). As this trip is examined as part of the course all students MUST attend. We will return in time for the school buses.

The trip will involve a human geography investigation in Manchester City Centre and a visit to the National Football Museum where we will carry out a guided workshop looking at the impact of sport and football on Manchester. Pupils will need a packed lunch and drink with them, there will not be time to go into shops. **Please MUST wear full school uniform** but bring weather appropriate additional clothing (sun cream if it is warm, coat if it is cold or wet).

The cost of the trip is £22.00. Please pay for this via ParentPay by 14th September 2023. Consent for the trip can also be given in ParentPay. If consent is not given, then we will be unable to let your child attend the trip.
