Dear Parents/Carers

Years 7 to 13 Rewards Afternoon - All Hallows College Staff v Sixth Form Football Match

Our Student Leadership Team have worked with Macclesfield FC, to organise a Staff V Sixth Form football match on the afternoon of Thursday 28th March.

We are planning to take students from all year groups to the stadium to watch the event as a reward for their hard work over the past term. Students will leave College after an early lunch and walk to the stadium on Moss Lane with their Form Tutor. The stadium is 2.5 km from the College. Students must be prepared for the walk with a coat with a hood or umbrella and bottle of water. Students with limited mobility or who may need extra support will be transported on the College minibus.

Students who travel to college on the college buses will be picked up from the stadium by the buses. Students who walk to college or are collected by parents/carers will be dismissed from the stadium by year group between 3.05 and 3.15 pm. **We therefore, kindly ask parents/carers to collect from the stadium car park rather than college on this day.**

Entry to the stadium is £2 payable on the day. Tickets can be purchased in advanced from the Sixth Form Common Room at a special rate of 2 for £3, with all monies going to the India Clinic. Students will have their lunch in College before heading to the stadium and will have the opportunity to purchase drinks and sweets before leaving the College site.

We hope that all students can attend this community event but as this is a 'Rewards afternoon', students are expected to be in positive 'SHINE' points by 26th March. Students have been repeatedly reminded of this during our assemblies and in a presentation which I shared when they returned to College on 26th February. Students in negative 'SHINE' points will be required to remain in College and will be dismissed from College as usual. Where students travel by College bus they will be transported to the stadium at 3.00 to transfer to the college buses.
