Years 10 & 11 Rewards Day Friday 22nd October 2021

You will recall that the Rewards Trip planned for last term had to be postponed due to COVID-19 restrictions in place within Cheshire East. The Rewards days activities have been rearranged to take place on **Friday 22nd October**. Many parents have already paid for the activity, others requested a refund at the time of cancellation so please check you 'ParentPay' account. If you are unsure you should call the Finance Office to speak with Mrs L Roberts.

The trip was organised as part of our 'Rewards & Behaviour' policy, and to mark what has been a difficult 16 months for our students. As this is a Rewards Trip the conditions remain the same as the original letter. Students should have maintained a positive number of SHINE points between 2 September and the date of the trip. All students are credited 30 SHINE points at the start of each half term. They add to these by being awarded Achievement points and reduce their SHINE points whenever they receive Behaviour points. We hope this motivates students to work hard and uphold our College expectations and values. With regret, due to the need to keep our students safe and in respect to this being a 'Rewards Trip' any student who has received a Fixed Term Exclusion between **7th June and the date of the trip will not be allowed to take part**. Should this happen following payment, parents/carers will be reimbursed.

As with all trips, these will only be able to take place if there are sufficient numbers and the full costs are met by parents/carers. Financial support will be offered to students who are in receipt of free school meals. You should contact Mrs L Roberts in the finance office for further details.

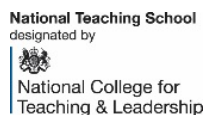
The following activities are available

1. Alton Towers, including transport £27 – Students will require a packed lunch or money to buy lunch in the park. Students in receipt of FSM will be provided with a packed lunch. *Parents/carers are asked to note that as the coaches will not return to college until 5.30pm, arrangements will need to be made to pick up those students who usually travel on the College bus.*
2. The Trafford Centre, transport only £8 – Students will have the opportunity to shop, visit the cinema, indoor golf or bowling and eat in the food court. All entrance fees/cost of food to be paid by students on the day depending on their personal choice of activities. Students in receipt of FSM will be provided with a packed lunch. Students will return to College in time for the end of day buses.
3. Onsite activities including Sports and a Film afternoon £3 to include sweets/popcorn. Usual lunch arrangements apply.
