Year 13	Unit of work	Intent
Autumn	Britain 1979-1990	Students will analyse the Thatcher period in terms of the policies both domestically and abroad. What did Thatcherism do to the UK? Students will be able to articulate their thoughts on policies such as monetarism, the Falklands War, privatisation and the poll tax.
	The USA 1920-1945	Students will analyse presidential policies of the 1920s and consider the impact of the 1929 Wall Street Crash. The development of the New Deal and the presidency of Franklin D Roosevelt. How did this presidency differ from the others. How did the USA emerge as the world's richest and strongest country?
Spring	Britain 1990-2007	What was the legacy of Thatcherism on Britain? How were the governments of John Major and Tony Blair different or similar to this? How was Britain emerging socially, economically and in its foreign policy? Close consideration of the War in Iraq in 2003.
	The USA 1945-1975	How did the USA approach the Cold War domestically and abroad? What were the policies of Eisenhower, Kennedy, Lyndon B Johnson, Richard Nixon and Gerald Ford? How did the USA emerge socially, and did the lives of American Americans improve in the period? What state was the USA in 1975?
