Dear Parent/Carer,

The Science department has organised a trip to Valencia in in 2023. The trip is from: 17/02/2022 - 21/02/2022. The estimated price is £600 per person, although this could go up or down slightly depending on the cost of flights at the time of booking. This price includes bed and breakfast accommodation, all activities, airport transfers in Valencia, flights. We will be staying in hostel accommodation where students will share dormitory style rooms with other students from our college. The price also includes an evening meal on the night of arrival.

The following activities are planned for the trip (although some are weather dependent, and an alternative may be found in the case of inclement weather).

- Visit to City of Arts & Sciences including a visit to the chromosome forest
- Visit to Oceanografic Europe's largest aquarium with a behind the scenes tour
- Visit to Hemisferic
- Visit to the Bioparc including a visit to Lake Albufera
- A walking tour of the city
- Visit to the botanical gardens

This is only open to pupils who will be in Year 12 – 13 during the school year 2022/23 and in the first instance places will only be given to those who are taking biology and Spanish that year.

Should you wish to book a place on the trip please log in to ParentPay to pay a non-refundable deposit of £100. There are 20 spaces available on this trip once we have filled these slots we may be able to speak with the travel company to assign more. Please contact the finance office if you do not secure a place but would like to attend.

We do not wish financial circumstances to prevent your child from participating so please contact Finance on the email below if you have any concerns of this nature. If you have any problems logging on to ParentPay or if your child is in receipt of free school meals and you require financial assistance please also contact: finance@allhallows.org.uk.

The payment schedule will be set out in ParentPay.

If you pull out of the trip you may lose all monies paid and be liable for any costs incurred by the school except in circumstances when your reason is covered by the insurance or where we can replace your child on the trip without charges being incurred. Behaviour will be assessed on the run up to the trip, any adverse behaviour will be discussed and reported to parents and if improvements are not made then removal from the trip may happen and any money paid towards the trip will not be refunded.
