Dear Parent / Carer,

Following on from my previous letter regarding the Year 11 Prom, I am pleased to be able to share with you information about the other events that are planned, to celebrate our students' time at All Hallows.

On Friday, 23 June students will be invited to a Leavers' Assembly & Rewards Day, which will include a celebration breakfast in College. By that time, students will have completed all of their exams, so it will be fitting to gather together in College, for one last time as a Year group, before setting off for a day to Alton Towers. A further letter, with full details, will follow shortly.

Most students who are attending the Prom have already paid two instalments, with the third and final instalment dates also having passed. Please ensure any remaining balance is paid as soon as possible.

I mentioned in my previous letter that the attendance of your son or daughter at the Prom is conditional on their behaviour, attendance and co-operation prior to the event, and that we reserve the right to withdraw places.

For students to take part in all of the above activities they must meet the following criteria:

- Students must attend all exams **AND** wear the correct College uniform
