This is your Bronze Passport: your challenge is to travel as much as possible through the world of words using your passport.

There are 4 stages – bronze, silver, gold and platinum. Everyone starts by aiming to achieve the ‘Bronze Award’ and the goal is to travel to the ultimate destination of a ‘Platinum Award’.

You should use your Reading Passport to keep track of your progress towards each award. Every time you read a book or complete another reading activity, make sure you record it in here. Be careful not to lose your passport.

Once you have completed four of the challenges and associated reading activities, you will be awarded a Bronze Award for Reading and move on to the Silver Reading Passport.

To achieve the bronze award for reading you need to complete at least **FOUR** of the reading activities below. When you have completed each activity, tell a parent, librarian or teacher about your book and ask them to sign your passport.

Reading Activity	Text and author	Signed by teacher, parent or librarian
Read at least one book from the recommended reading list		
Read a poem by a poet you've heard of but never read.		
Read a book of your choice		
Read a science-fiction or adventure novel		
Read a non-fiction article and complete an Accelerated Reader quiz on it.		
Read a detective or real-life drama novel		
Read a book of your choice		
Read a sports or comedy novel		
Read a fantasy or historical novel

If you haven't done an Accelerated Reading quiz for each book you've read, choose one of the reading activities below. If you want you could keep these in a reading scrapbook.

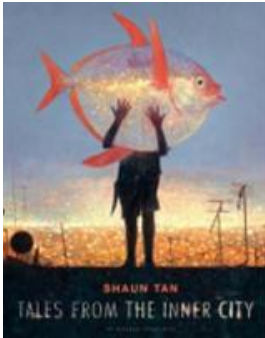
Reading Activity	Signed by teacher, parent or librarian

Create a storyboard of one the chapters in your book.	
Choose a character you would like to be and write at least one paragraph to explain why.	
Design a new front cover for the book	
Create a timeline of events in the story	
Write about how a character might be feeling at different stages in the story. You could write it in the first person, or in speech bubbles.
